CHANGES IN MASS INTENTIONS

One of the venerable traditions of the Catholic Church is the offering of the Mass for special intentions. Such occurrences as a death and its anniversary, marriage, birthdays, sickness or other special needs are ideal opportunities for having the Mass offered for such an intention. The most common is the offering of the Mass for the departed, to assist them on their journey home to the Father. You can request a Mass intention by calling Cecilia Rogers at the Administration Building front desk, Jeanne Girsch or Peggy Runnels. A \$5 offering is common practice, which is the joining of our little sacrifice to the sacrifice of the altar. Only the poor are exempt from this offering. In order to keep regular space in the list of intentions for our Masses since only one intention may be offered for each Mass, those requesting Masses are limited to three per month, unless the need is as the result of a death. Space is also available for our prayers in the general intercessions at the Mass. This is offered "freestyle" at the weekday Masses and spoken by the lector at the Sunday Mass.
